



Date Code System

Four Character System (YYWW):

YY = Last two digits of the year (00-99), repeats every one hundred years.
WW= Two digit week (01-52).

Three Character System (YWW):

Y = Last digit of the year (0-9), repeats every ten years.
WW= Two digit week (01-52).

Two Character System (YW):

Y = Year (0-9), repeats every ten years.
W= Week (1-52).
When Y is numeric (0-9), W is (A-Z) for weeks 1-26.
When Y is alpha (A-J), W is (A-Z) for weeks 27-52.
